1.1 School Mission (put forward by the School Sponsoring Body)

With biblical truth as our cornerstone, we seek to provide quality whole-person education to help the youth cultivate a wholesome attitude, realize their potentials and achieve a well-balanced development, spiritually, morally, intellectually, physically, socially and aesthetically. We strive to guide the young towards a life based on Christian virtues, Chinese culture and a global outlook. In our school, the children will live together in harmony, mutual respects, but are fearless to face their responsibilities. They are driven by a desire to care about the community, serve mankind and not least, their country.

1.2 School Vision (put forward by the school)

To fulfill the school mission, we have to make every effort to build the capacity of teachers to learn, teach and excel in teaching. We seek to develop teachers to build a needs-satisfying school in which the needs of students (relationship, power, fun, freedom and survival) are satisfied, the self-worth of students is built, the self-concept of students is developed and the academic and non-academic potential of students are realized to fullness. We strive to implement Life Value Education which helps students to explore, acquire and apply values of Chinese culture and of Christian faith in the context of personal, social, societal, national and global domains.

Briefly list the feedback and follow-up actions from the previous school year:

- 1. The school made more intensive use of data to substantiate her progress particularly in the evaluation of learning & teaching. It was agreed that the school should make use of data & evidence more widely in PIE on the one hand, meeting the requirement of enhanced School Development & Accountability framework of EDB; on the other hand, informing our progress timelier & more accurately.
- 2. The school has renewed her IT infra-structure for securing data security, connectivity, using technology to foster learning, classroom teaching, STEAM education, organization & management. It was agreed to start building the culture of using technology to transform our practices to higher level.
- 3. The school explored & developed various strategic practices, e.g. Monthly Attitude Mark, Benchmarking Task & Mark, AI-facilitated Reading & Assessment, AI-facilitated Writing & Assessment, Class Climate Building, PASS Model of Tripartite Collaboration, Cycle of Initiation, Implementation & Improvement, High IP Index Strategic Actions, etc. To consolidate or further develop the practices as well as to adopt the new requirement of using data & technology, the school needs to develop heads of subject panels/SDSCs to supervise & lead. With such capacity, the stage of development would shift from initial attempt, mechanical adoption, congruent adoption to institutionalization.
